PE

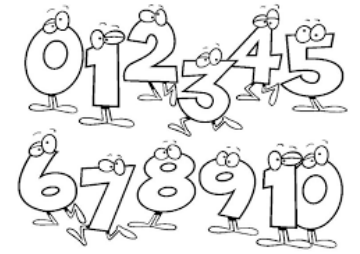
In PE we will be focusing on our dance performance for the Celebration of Dance, then developing our gymnastics skills, creating our own routines to perform.
