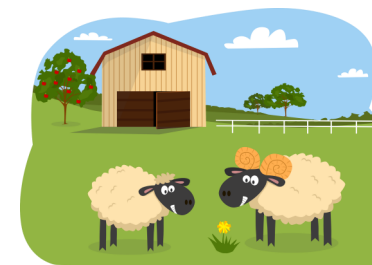

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Literacy in Classes 1 & 2:

All children will continue to take part in daily Little Wandle phonics sessions and three small group reading practise sessions per week.

We will be using different forms of writing such as making lists and posters during our 3 Pigs Adventure We will also be working on the following:

- Correct letter formation and thinking about using finger spaces in our independent writing.
- Trying to use the sounds that we have learnt in our writing.

Maths in Classes 1 & 2:



We will be learning to:

- Talk about and name 3D shapes and their properties
- Build and identify numbers to 20 using a range of resources.
- Explore number bonds to 10, using real objects in different contexts.
- Practising counting on from different starting points.
- Exploring the number 100.
- Exploring how shapes can be combined and separated to make new shapes.
- Exploring the concept of taking away.

You can help your child by

- Talking with them as much as you can about anything and everything.
- Learning the names of a whole variety of baby animals.
- Reading lots of traditional stories and encouraging your child to join in.
- Enjoy singing the songs and rhymes on the sheet provided.
- Playing simple board games together.
- Listen to your child read their phonic book as frequently as possible.
- Enjoy reading the shared book your child has chosen together.
