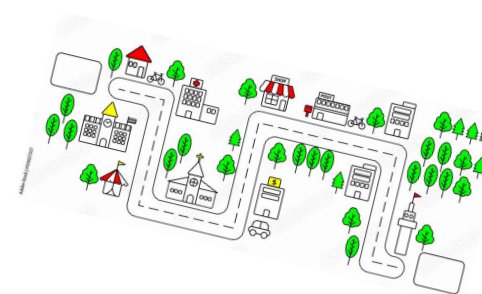




Shelton Infant School

Year 1 Newsletter- Autumn 2 2022



Music We will be learning to move in time to a steady beat and clap simple long and short rhythms. We will learn about pulse, rhythm and pitch, and how to sing simple high and low patterns. We will also be learning lots of fun Christmas songs to sing in our Christmas Concert.

Geography We will be learning to use maps to explore our school grounds, Shelton Lock and Derby. We will be learning what human and physical features are and identify examples of these in our local area.

Computing We will learn about presenting data in the form of pictograms and about uses for technology outside school.

Design and Technology

We will learn how to make a Christmas decoration with moving parts. We will design our decoration, make the parts and evaluate our design.

RE This term we will learn the Christian Christmas story and how Christians celebrate Christmas.

Science - Animals We will be learning about that different types of animals in the world. We will learn how to group animals according to what they eat- Herbivore, Carnivore, Omnivore. We will also be learning the classifications of animals- Reptiles, Fish, Amphibians, Mammals and Birds.

PE We will be developing our running skills this half term, working on the correct technique for running as well as using running in games. We will also develop our gymnastic skills, using wide, narrow and curled shapes.

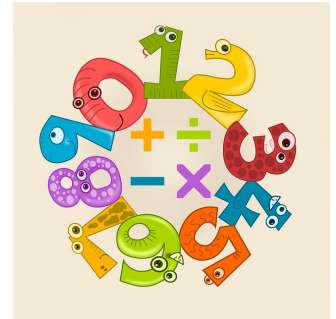
