Geography In Geography we will be recapping the continents and oceans before moving onto a country study of China.

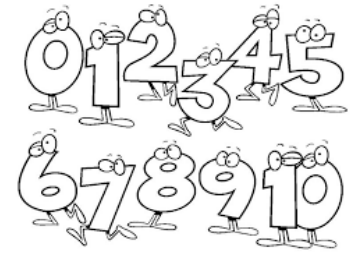
