Curriculum Newsletter June 2018 Summer Term 2

Our topic is THE ENCHANTED WOODLAND

English

We will be preparing for the phonics check, which begins week commencing 11th June. We will read traditional tales and poems that contain suffixes and prefixes. We will be writing our own stories. We will talk about the poems and traditional tales we are reading thinking what could happen next and why things have happened and we will answer questions about what we have read. We will retell familiar traditional tales and learn to recite poems.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on counting to 100 and in multiples of 2s, 5s and 10s. Reading and writing words to twenty. We will be adding and subtracting and solving problems that involve these skills. We will be recapping number bonds to 20 and related subtraction facts. We will continue to learn to recognise and know the volume of different coins and notes and telling the time.

Science

In science we will be learning about plants. We will look at plants, we will describe them and look at different parts of a plant. We will look at plants that give us food and carry out a growth experiment.

We will learn about online safety and the importance of being safe online. We will create poster about online safety and learn the rules to stay safe online.

RE and PSHÉ

In RE we will be learning about Judaism. We will complete a workshop carried out by the open centre to learn about different aspects of Judaism. In PSHE we will be talking about transition to their new classes and making new friends. We will also cover 'Stranger Danger' and how to stay safe when playing outside. D&T

In D+T we will be learning about food hygiene, thinking about having good hygiene skills before cooking. We will make and decorate biscuits for Father's Day. We will look at different tastes and textures using adjectives to describe these. We will talk about our favourite sandwich fillers, design and make our own sandwiches.

PE

This term during PE we will introduce Yoga. We will learn a variety of yoga poses through different stories and role play. We will also practise races for sports day.

Music

In music we will be continuing to learn songs in preparation for the Allenton Singing Party. We will also be practising our class assembly, which we hope you enjoy watching!

Please try to hear your child read their book and learn their words read 3 times a week and write in their reading diary.
